Senior and Any Age Classes

301 **Recital Class** £11.50

OPEN (see Rule 1) any age (Grades approx. 6 and over)
Own choice of two or more pieces by contrasting composers not exceeding a total of 15 minutes
Credit will be given for playing from memory
Prize: DOROTHY ALLEN SENIOR RECITAL CUP

302 **Baroque Class** £7.00

16 years and over
Own choice from a work written by a Baroque composer before 1750 (8 minutes)
Prize: BACH SENIOR CHALLENGE CUP

303 **Classical Period** £8.00

16 years and over
Own choice of one movement of a sonata or a work of comparable stature, written by a classical period composer between 1750 and 1828 (10 minutes)
Prize: MURIEL HOLLAND MOZART MEMORIAL CUP

304 **Romantic Composer** £7.00

16 years and over
Own choice of a work from the romantic period by Mendelssohn, Chopin, Liszt, Schumann, Brahms or similar (8 minutes)
Prize: CHOPIN CUP

305 **French Composer** £6.50

16 years and over
Own choice of a work by a French Composer (7 minutes)

306 **Twentieth Century / Contemporary Composer** £6.50

16 years and over
Own choice of a work composed after 1945 (7 minutes)

Prize: JUNIOR RECITAL CUP

312 **Bursary Class**

Competitors **must enter two classes** of the same age group in order to qualify - one Classical Period (classes 321, 322, or 323) **plus** one Own Choice Class (classes 324, 325 or 326). The two competitors from each age group with the highest total marks (not less than 170) will re-perform their two pieces at the final session of the Festival for a **BURSARY PRIZE of £50**, generously donated by the H R Taylor Trust. Entry for the Bursary is not compulsory. Each class may be entered separately and carries its own award, but nobody may enter for more than **ONE** age group.

Classical Period

Own choice from a work written by a classical period composer between 1750 and 1828
The BEETHOVEN JUNIOR CUP will be awarded to the competitor with the highest mark in Classes 321 to 323

Own choice of music by one composer born from 1800 onwards
